A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RAYMOND

How are you getting on learning God's language? When we learn a new language it takes time just to remember the basic syllable, yet alone to be able to speak fluently. Many Christians have problems learning the basics of God's language. Then as they try to speak God's language, they find it difficult, get the basics wrong, it's very hard to get the rest right. And, as you progress in learning God's language if at any time you refuse to learn a new revealed truth given to you through the Holy Spirit, you will never progress or learn any more because you have stunted your growth. God cannot give you any more revealed truth, you will stay as you are, going from fellowship to fellowship, or, removing yourself from active fellowship. Now moving forward to those who want to speak God's language.

When you really KNOW Christ, you know His promises, begin to speak God's language, confessing and claiming His promises which are covered in faith. 3 promises which release the power of God to work on your behalf, these refer to health and healing in your body.

"I am the Lord that healeth thee" – Ex 15 v 26.

"Bless the Lord, O my soul and forget not all His benefits. Who forgiveth all thine (my) iniquities, who healeth all thy (my) diseases" - Psalm 103 v 2,3,

"But He was wounded for our (my) transgressions, He was bruised for our (my) iniquities, the chastisement of our (my) peace was upon Him and with His stripes we are (I am) healed" - Isaiah 53v5.

When we talk these words we are talking God's language, and as we talk these words we talk faith. Have you ever thought about talking faith to one another? We are so ready to talk of sickness, so ready to talk doubt and unbelief, so easily talk about fear, defeat and discouragement, so keen to talk about the past. This is not 'God's language'. When we contemplate our conversations we have, especially with other Christians or non-Christians, we can see what we are saying. When we continually talk about our sickness, moaning, complaining, groaning about When we speak words of fear, doubt, unbelief, we block the manifestation of God's activeness in our lives.

The 'power of Christ' to release healing, provision, deliverance, in our lives are in 'His WORD'.
